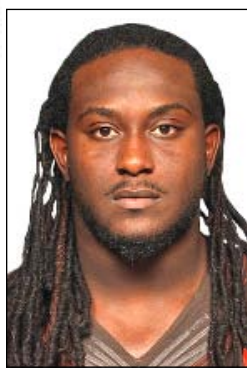

CROWELL: Funs for season-high 152 yards in season-ending game vs. Pittsburgh. Finishes the season with 935 yards.

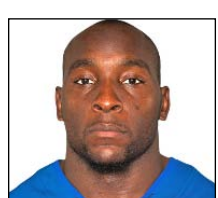

DEFENSE

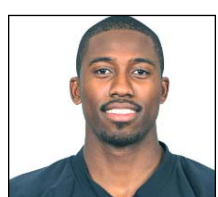


- **ROBERT MATHIS**, OLB, Indianapolis (14th season, ALABAMA A&M) - Recorded three solo tackles, including a sack, forced fumble and fumble recovery in his last game as he announced that he is retiring. Mathis finishes the season with 20 tackles, five sacks and three forced fumbles. For his Hall of Fame career, Mathis has 123 sacks and 54 forced fumbles.



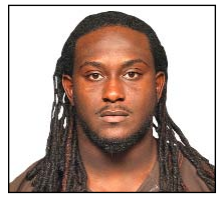
- **DOMINIQUE RODGERS-CROMARTIE**, CB, NY Giants (9th season, TENNESSEE STATE) - Posted one solo tackle, a sack, two assists and two interceptions in win over Washington. DRC finishes the regular season with 49 tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and a career-high tying six interceptions (2009).

SPECIAL TEAMS



- **MARQUETTE KING**, P, Oakland (5th season, FORT VALLEY STATE) - Eight punts for 45.3-yard average with a long punt of 68 yards in loss to Denver. Five of his punts were downed inside the 20. For the season, King averaged 48.6 yards per punt, third highest average in the NFL, with a long punt of 72 yards and 34 downed inside the 20.

OFFENSE



- **ISIAH CROWELL**, RB, Cleveland (5th season, ALABAMA STATE) - Ran 19 times for 152 yards including a 67-yard run in loss to Pittsburgh. Also had three receptions for 16 yards. He also lost one fumble. Crowell finishes the season with career-highs of 198 carries for 935 yards. He also scored 7 TDs. He had 40 receptions for 319 yards.

OTHER TOP PERFORMANCES

SPECIAL TEAMS

- **ERIC WEEMS**, WR/KR, Atlanta (10th season, BETHUNE-COOKMAN) - Three punt returns for 13 yards with a long return of 16 yards in win over New Orleans. Weems has 24 punt returns on the season for an 11.4-yard average with a long of 73 yards. Also returned 17 kickoffs for 381 yards (23.0 ypr.) with a long of 42. He also had 16 special teams' tackles.

OFFENSE

- **CHESTER ROGERS**, WR/KR, Indianapolis (1st season, GRAMBLING STATE) - Four receptions for 72 yards with a long catch of 21 yards in win over Jacksonville. Finished his first NFL season with 19 receptions for 273 yards averaging 14.3 yards per catch with no touchdowns. He also returned 13 punts for 119 yards (9.2 ypr.).

DEFENSE

- **RODNEY GUNTER**, DT, Arizona (2nd season, DELAWARE STATE) - Two solo tackles, one an assist, a half-sack, in win over Los Angeles. On the season, Gunter totalled 15 tackles and 1.5 sacks.
- **JAVON HARGRAVE**, DT, Pittsburgh (1st season, SOUTH CAROLINA STATE) - Two solo tackles in win over Cleveland. Hargrave had 27 tackles in his first season with two sacks and one fumble recovery for a touchdown.
- **DEJI OLATOYE**, DB, Atlanta (2nd season, NORTH CAROLINA A&T) - One solo tackle in win over New Orleans. Totalled four tackles on the season.
- **WILLIAM HAYES**, DE, LA Rams (9th season, WINSTON-SALEM STATE) - Two solo tackles, one a sack, in loss to Arizona. Hayes finishes the season with 43 tackles and five sacks.
- **ANTOINE BETHEA**, S, San Francisco (11th season, HOWARD) - Led 49ers with six solo tackles and one assist in loss to Seattle. Bethea finishes the season with 110 tackles, one interception and one forced fumble.
- **CHRIS BAKER**, DE, Washington (5th season, HAMPTON) - Two solo tackles and three assists in loss to the NY Giants. Baker completed the season with 47 tackles, 3.5 sacks and two forced fumbles.
- **RAFAEL BUSH**, SS, Detroit (6th season, SOUTH CAROLINA STATE) - No stats this week. For the season, Bush had 53 tackles (fifth on team) with 46 solos and one sack.
- **DON CAREY**, S, Detroit (8th season, NORFOLK STATE) - Two solo tackles and one assist in loss to Green Bay. Despite injuries, Carey finished the regular season with 13 tackles and one forced fumble.
- **GREG TOLER**, DB, Washington (8th season, SAINT PAUL'S) - Two solo tackles and one assist in loss to the NY Giants. Toler had 18 tackles this season.
